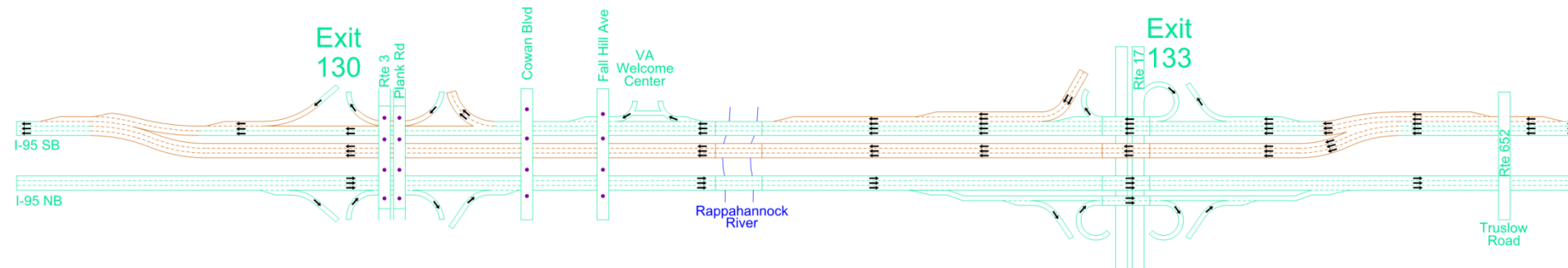
Purpose and Need

- Reduce congestion
- Improve accessibility and mobility to and within the surrounding activity and employment centers
- Improve safety in heavy weaving and merging areas
- Address current and planned growth that will increase traffic volumes by 44-52% by 2040

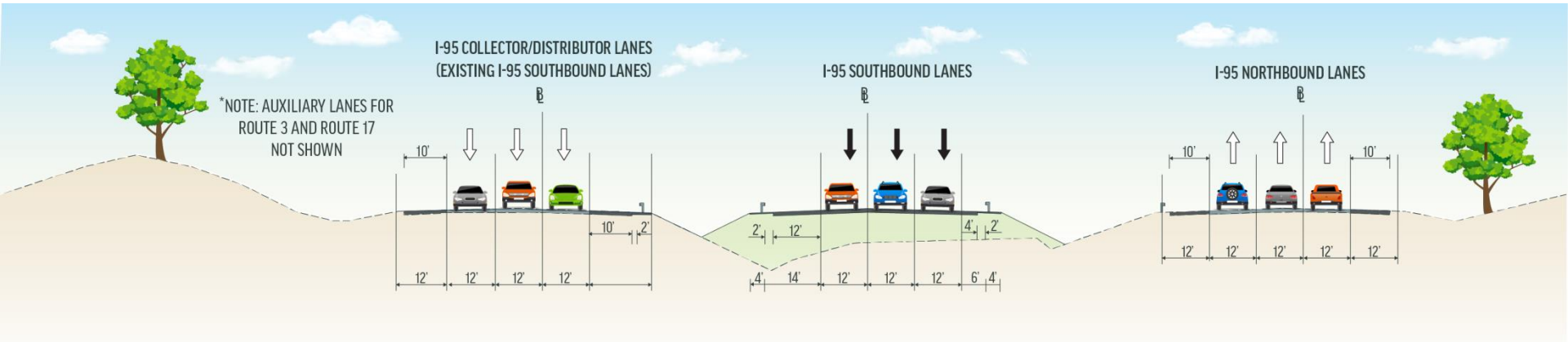
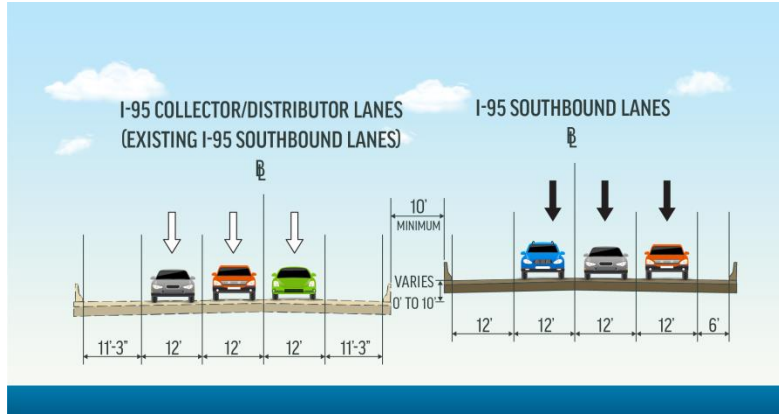


Proposed Concept

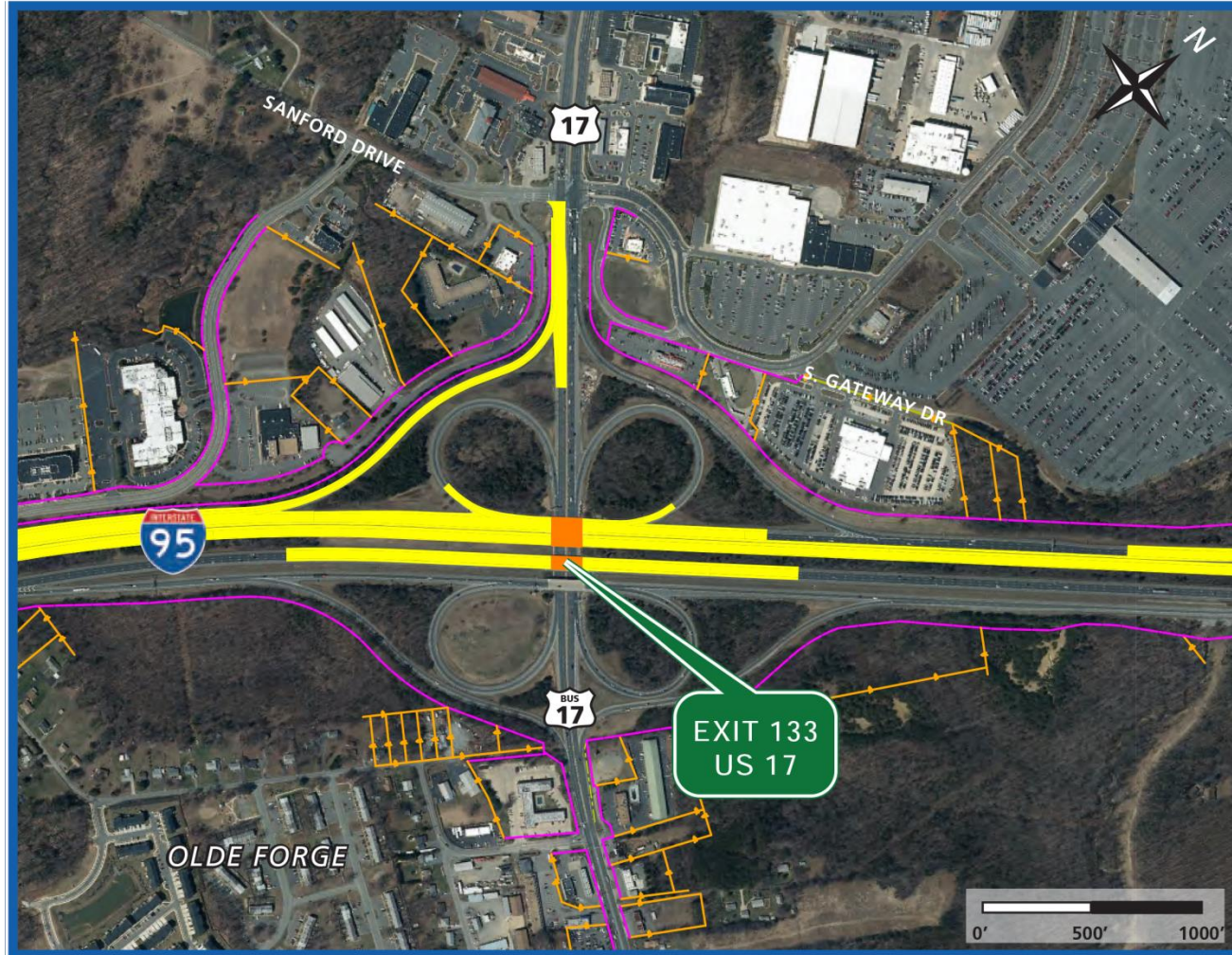
- **Convert 3 existing lanes** to collector-distributor lanes for local traffic on I-95 southbound
- In the median, construct **3 through traffic lanes** on I-95 southbound
- **Construct new bridge** over the Rappahannock River to carry the through lanes in median
- **New lanes built from just north of Exit 133/Route 17** in Stafford County to just south of **Exit 130/Route 3** interchange in Fredericksburg



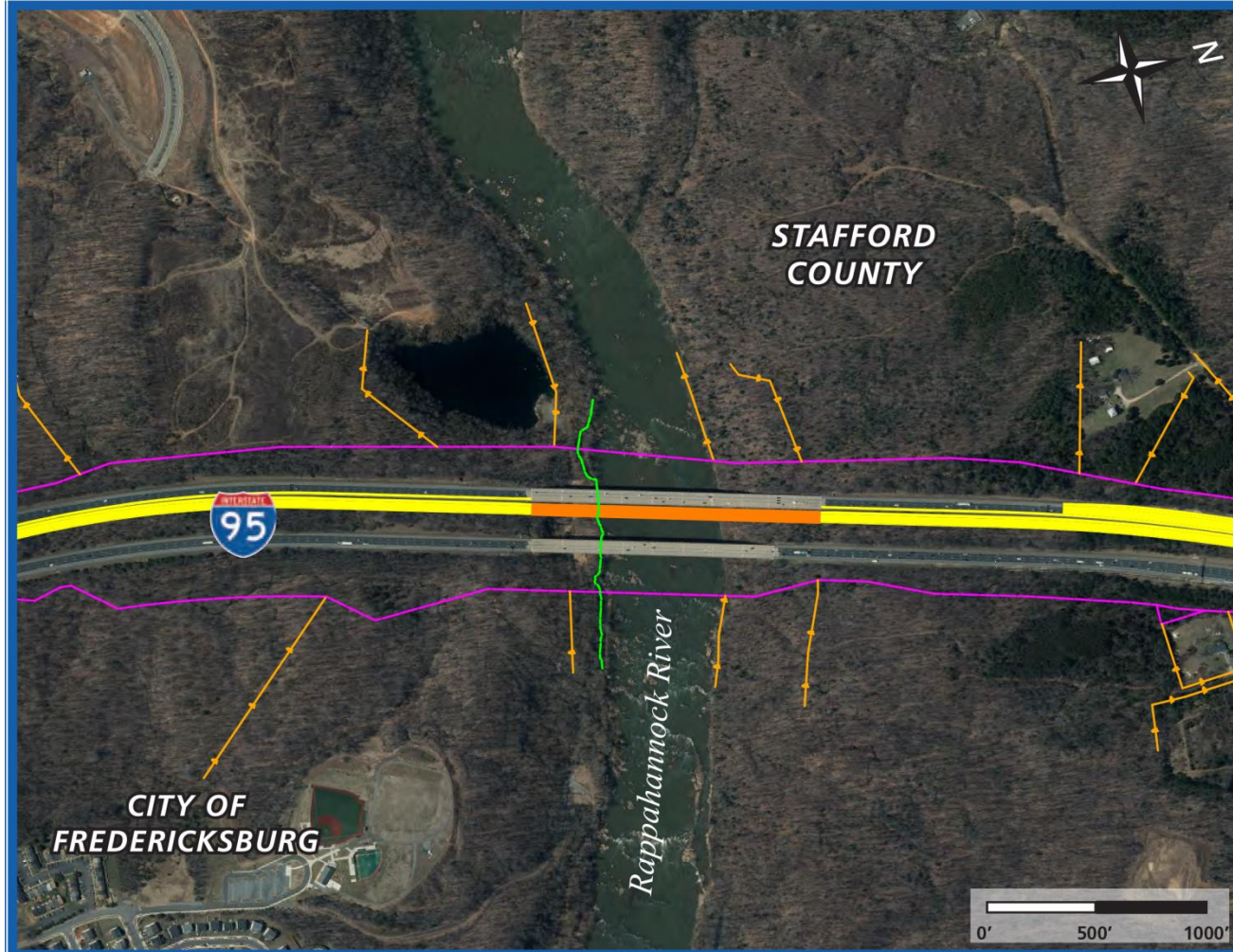
Typical Section



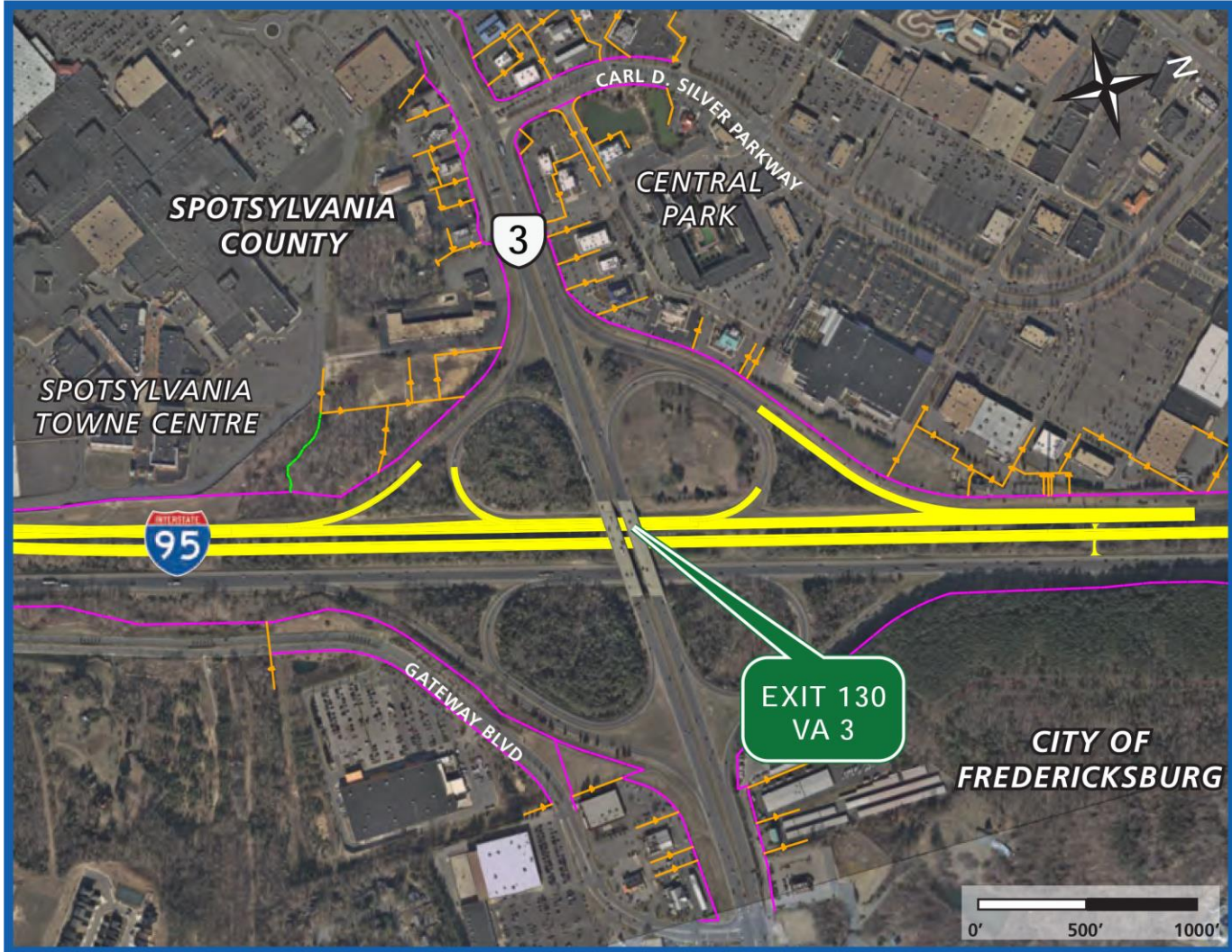
I-95 at Route 17 (Exit 133)
