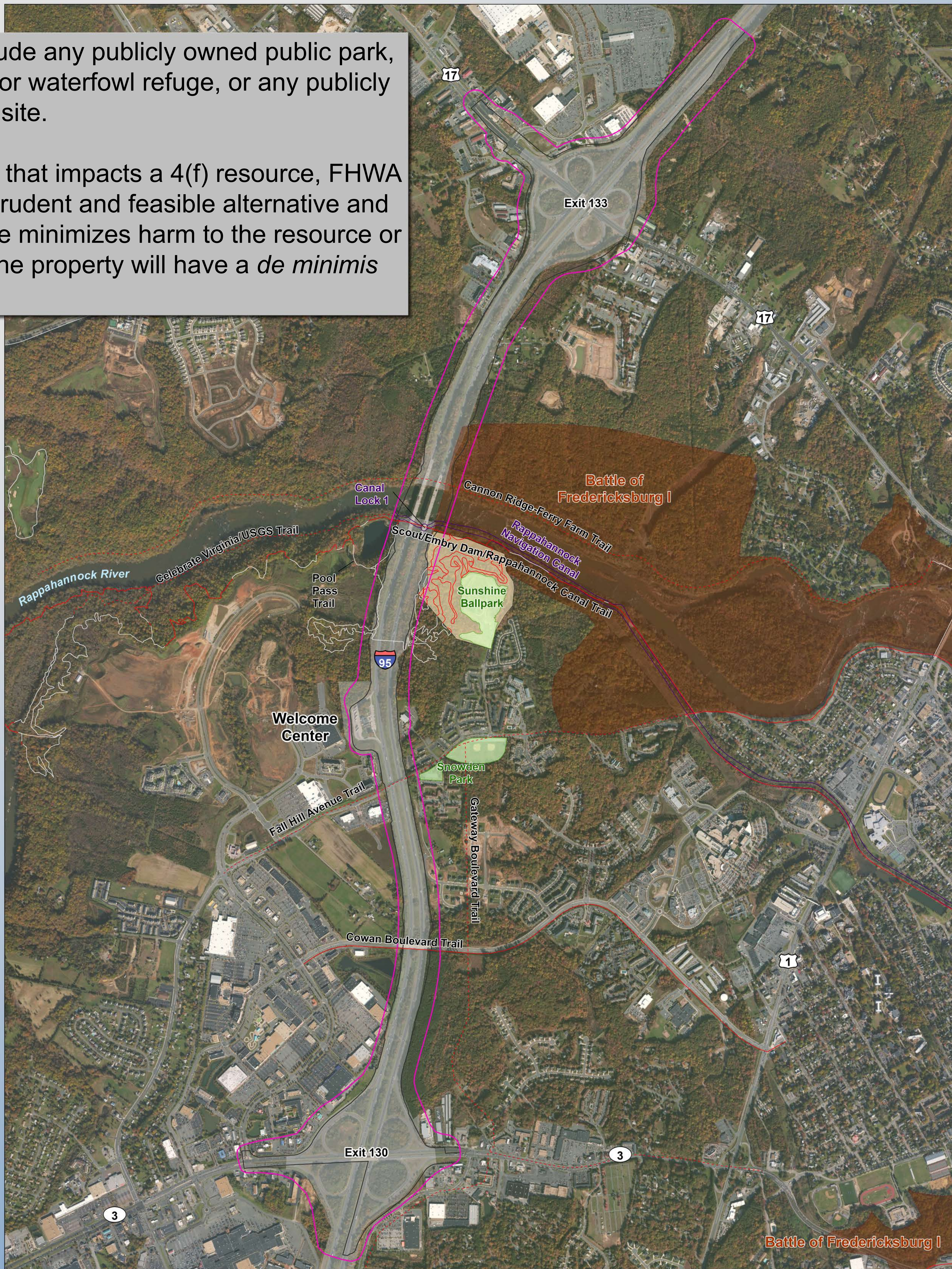


SECTION 4(f) RESOURCES

Section 4(f) resources include any publicly owned public park, recreation area, or wildlife or waterfowl refuge, or any publicly or privately owned historic site.

Before approving a project that impacts a 4(f) resource, FHWA must find that there is no prudent and feasible alternative and that the selected alternative minimizes harm to the resource or determine that the use of the property will have a *de minimis* impact.
